

#### WHY CHRISTIANS DON'T KEEP KOSHER

Other than the main reason being that Christians believe 'Jesus' abolished all of the laws that His Father created and that he kept his entire life, there are also a few other key scriptures that have lead Christians to believe that the dietary laws of YHWH no longer apply to them. We're going to look into a few of these scriptures to reveal the true message they were trying to convey, and show that YHWH's dietary are still very much in operation today.

# INCORRECT INTERPRETATIONS OF THE WORD LEAVE YAHSHUA LOOKING LIKE THIS:



### MARK

Many misunderstand a scripture in Mark as Yahshua declaring all animals to be purified, this, however is not the case; let's have a look at what the scriptures say:

Mark 7:1-3 Then the Pharisees and some of the scribes came together to Him, having come from Jerusalem. 2 Now when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with defiled, that is, with unwashed hands, they found fault. 3 For the Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they wash their hands in a special way, holding the tradition of the elders.

Note that the washing of hands is a tradition of the elders and not a commandment from YHWH. Although it is not wrong to eat with washed hands, it is not a commandment from YHWH, neither and should not be seen as having spiritual substance. The Pharisees and scribes condemned His disciples for not adhering to this man-made commandment of washing hands before eating, and therefore, according to the Pharisees; became 'defiled' or 'unclean' in the eyes of YHWH.


YHWH responds by saying their priorities are wrong in whom they choose to obey. They placed the commandments of men over the commandments of Yahuwah.

Mark 7:4-7 When they come from the marketplace, they do not eat unless they wash. And there are many other things which they have received and hold, like the washing of cups, pitchers, copper vessels, and couches.

5 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?"

6 He answered and said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honours Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me. 7 And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'

Here we can see that the Pharisees chastised Yahshua's disciples for not 'walking according to the tradition of the elders', but Yahshua bit back, declaring them to be the hypocrites described Isaiah, stating that their hearts are from YHWH and that they worship Him in vain with their man-made commandments.



- Mark 7:8-18 You have let go of the commands of YHWH and are holding on to the traditions of men."
- 9 And he said to them: "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of YHWH in order to observe your own traditions!
- 10 For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death.'
- 11 But you say that if a man says to his father or mother: 'Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is Corban' (that is, a gift devoted to YHWH),
- 12 then you no longer let him do anything for his father or mother.

13 Thus you nullify the word of YHWH by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that." 14 Again Yahshua called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this. 15 Nothing outside a man can make him 'unclean' by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him 'unclean.'

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17 After he had left the crowd and entered the house, his disciples asked him about this parable. 18 "Are you so dull?" he asked. "Don't you see that nothing that enters a man from the outside can make him 'unclean'? 19 For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body."

Yahshua chastised the Pharisees for their commandments of men, as they nullify the law of YHWH through it, therefore breaking Deuteronomy 4:2 which says not to take away or add to scripture.

Yahshua finishing on a statement that has been misunderstood throughout the Church for many years; Yahshua says that "Nothing outside a man can make him 'unclean' by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him 'unclean' for it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body".

Some bible translations have actually added in the statement, 'Jesus through this purified all foods'.

Firstly not once in scripture are non-kosher animals referred to as non-kosher 'food' or unclean 'food'. They are referenced as unclean 'animals', that are not to even be viewed as food, they are not food to us. Leviticus 20:25 'You shall therefore distinguish between clean animals and unclean, between unclean birds and clean, and you shall not make yourselves abominable by beast or by bird, or by any kind of living thing that creeps on the ground, which I have separated from you as unclean.' In Leviticus, it does not say 'these are the foods that you must not eat', it refers to each unclean animal by their species, because these animals are biblically considered food, they are considered unclean ANIMALS not food.

# UNKOSHER ANIMALS ARE NOT FOOD!



Yahshua's disciples were not being criticized for eating unclean animals, they were being criticized for eating without washing their hands according to the "tradition of the elders."

The Pharisees believed their hands were defiled because of this, so everything they ate was also defiled.

This is the reason why Yahshua said in verse 19 'For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body.' He was not speaking of unclean animals going into the body, but food that had been declared 'defiled' by the Pharisees through a lack of hand washing and not by YHWH's law decreeing the food to be defiled.

But Yahshua declared to them that they, nor their food was not defiled by eating with unwashed hands.


Then He gave a "parable" saying; "There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man."

This was a parable, which are generally metaphors and allegories, and are not generally intended to be taken literally because His disciples later "asked him concerning the parable." And Yahshua clarified his meaning...

# YAHSHUA EXPLAINED HIS PARABLE IN DETAIL




- Mark 7:20-23 And He said, "What comes out of a man, that defiles a man. 21 "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 "thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. 23 "All these evil things come from within and defile a man."
- To confirm He was not speaking of unclean meats not defiling a man, consider the parallel of Yahshua's saying here in the book of Matthew where the same story is told:
- Matthew 15:19-20 "For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. 20 "These are the things which defile a man, but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile a man."



Through this scripture we see that it was the evil coming out of the heart that defiled a man, not eating with unwashed hands. Yahshua's statement was not intended abolish His Father's dietary laws, but to point out the frivolity and inaccuracy of man made laws. Yahshua does not once invalidate His Father's laws in the Scriptures, to the contrary, he observed them and encouraged his followers in the observance of them.

If Yahshua came to do away with all of 613 of Yahuwah's laws, laws that not only He kept throughout his life, but that the entire Jewish nation kept, you think the Pharisees would have chastised Him for that and not just for eating with unwashed hands.

## YAHSHUA KEPT ALL THE KOSHER FOOD LAWS



#### EXPLAINING ACTS 10

Acts 10:1-14 There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian Regiment, 2 a devout man and one who feared Yahuwah with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to YHWH always. 3 About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of YHWH coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius!" 4 And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, Master?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before YHWH. 5 "Now send men to Joppa, and send for Simon whose surname is Peter. 6 "He is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea. He will tell you what you must do."



7 And when the angel who spoke to him had departed, Cornelius called two of his household servants and a devout soldier from among those who waited on him continually. 8 So when he had explained all these things to them, he sent them to Joppa.

9 The next day, as they went on their journey and drew near the city, Peter went up on the housetop to pray, about the sixth hour. 10 Then he became very hungry and wanted to eat; but while they made ready, he fell into a trance 11 and saw heaven opened and an object like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the earth.



12 In it were all kinds of four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air. 13 And a voice came to him, "Rise, Peter; kill and eat." 14 But Peter said, "Not so, Master! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean."


Now consider this, Peter declares that he has never eaten anything common or unclean. Yet this is many years after Yahshua's resurrection and ascension.

If Yahshua had declared all animals clean in Mark 7:19, as many Christians believe he did, then why would one of Yahshua's disciples still refer to these animals as unclean and continue on in abstaining from the consumption of them? Continuing on...

Acts 10:14-17 But Peter said, "Not so, Master! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean." 15 And a voice spoke to him again the second time, "What YHWH has cleansed you must not call common." 16 This was done three times. And the object was taken up into heaven again. 17 Now while Peter wondered within himself what this vision which he had seen meant...

Now many would like to stop right here and declare that it is now acceptable to eat unclean animals. But according to the previous verse, Peter himself didn't even know what the vision meant. How then can we interpret the vision? Peter knew that it was always considered an "abomination" to eat the flesh of unclean animals and that we should not make ourselves "abominable" by eating them (Leviticus 20:25), so you can understand his confusion when YHWH, the creator of these laws, offered him these animals as food.


Peter knew that for YHWH to change his mind and declare animals he once deemed 'abominable' to now be clean wouldn't be possible, because he knew that in Malachi 3:6 and Numbers 23:19 YHWH states that he does not change, and neither does his mind. So what did Peter's vision mean?



Acts 10:17-28 Now while Peter wondered within himself what this vision which he had seen meant, behold, the men who had been sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate. 18 And they called and asked whether Simon, whose surname was Peter, was lodging there.

19 While Peter thought about the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are seeking you. 20 "Arise therefore, go down and go with them, doubting nothing; for I have sent them." 21 Then Peter went down to the men who had been sent to him from Cornelius, and said, "Yes, I am he whom you seek. For what reason have you come?"

22 And they said, "Cornelius the centurion, a just man, one who fears YHWH and has a good reputation among all the nation of the Jews, was divinely instructed by a holy angel to summon you to his house, and to hear words from you."



- 23 Then he invited them in and lodged them. On the next day Peter went away with them, and some brethren from Joppa accompanied him. 24 And the following day they entered Caesarea. Now Cornelius was waiting for them, and had called together his relatives and close friends.
- 25 As Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him and fell down at his feet and worshiped him. 26 But Peter lifted him up, saying, "Stand up; I myself am also a man." 27 And as he talked with him, he went in and found many who had come together.
- 28 Then he said to them, "You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But YWHW has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean.



- This vision had nothing to do with YHWH trying to teach Peter that it is now lawful to eat unclean animals, but rather YHWH was trying to show Peter and the disciples the importance of sharing the good news of Yahshua with the Gentiles, those men considered 'unclean' by Jewish tradition.
- Yahshua had commanded the disciples to "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations.." in Matthew 28 but up until that point they had failed to do so. So YHWH sent a vision to Peter to teach him that contrary to popular Jewish opinion during that time it was not 'unlawful' or against the commandment of YHWH to go "keep company with or go to one of another nation."

#### I HAVE BEEN GIVEN COMPLETE AUTHORITY IN HEAVEN AND ON EARTH

THEREFORE

### make disciples of all the nations

baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit
Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you

AND BE SURE OF THIS

I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS EVEN TO THE END OF THE AGE

The Jews would not do so because they considered people of another nation or 'Gentiles' to be defiled and unclean to even keep company with. This opinion of Gentile nations is not biblical. Such enmity between Jew and Gentile was never intended by YHWH at all! It wasn't unlawful according to the Torah of YHWH, but the traditions of man. The word "unlawful" in the above verse is translated from the Greek word Athemitos (#111) which carries the following meaning:


"This term refers primarily not to what is forbidden by ordinance but to violation of tradition or common recognition of what is seemly or proper." Greek-English Lexicon of the New Testament and Other Early Christian Literature, Third Edition.

### DO NOT TREAT ANY MAN WITH CONTEMPT, BUT LOVE YOUR FELLOW MAN



In YHWH's law, it never says to separate yourself from the Gentile and treat him with contempt.

Rather it says: Exodus 22:21 "You shall neither mistreat a stranger nor oppress him, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.



Therefore, it is clear that YHWH never inspired or intended such practices. Many of the Jews during that time were so obsessed with cleanliness that they added hundreds of laws to the Torah which YHWH never intended or inspired.

Peter needed to be corrected in this area and this was the purpose of the vision; not to declare the cleanliness of animals once considered abominable, but to allow Peter to recognize that man made doctrine is not in accordance with YHWH's doctrine.

## 1 TIMOTHY

 1 Timothy 4:1-3 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, 2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron, 3 forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from foods which Elohim created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.

For those who eat unclean animals, it wouldn't be difficult to misunderstand the meaning of this scripture, and assume that Paul is calling those who only believe in eating clean animals as those who follow "doctrines of demons" because they believe in abstaining from 'certain foods'.

But demons didn't create the dietary laws, YHWH did, therefore this passage could not be referring to those who keep kosher. The scripture says that some will be "commanding to abstain from foods which YHWH created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth."

Those who believe and know the truth are those who know and understand YHWH's Word, in which it states that he created some animals that are unclean to eat and some that are clean to eat.

YHWH created certain animals (such as sheep and cattle) to be received with thanksgiving.

### The Clean (Shall be eaten)



Deer



Cow



Salmon



Turkey



Grasshopper

Unclean animals however; such as pork and shellfish were never intended to be food for those who 'believe and know the truth' and these unclean animals were certainly never created 'to be received with thanksgiving'.

With this in mind, let's read the following verse: 4 For every creature of YHWH is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; 5 for it is sanctified by the word of YHWH and prayer.



After reading the above verses, some have mistakenly thought that as long as they pray before they eat an unclean animal, YHWH cleanses it for them. However this is a very inaccurate interpretation of the verse.


Many read the 5<sup>th</sup> verse as 'FOR IF IT IS SANCTIFIED' (it should not be refused) but the Scripture actually says 'FOR IT IS SANCTIFIED',

This verse is not saying that unclean animals can be made clean if we sanctify them to Him, he is stating that within His Word, He has already sanctified the animals that are to be received with thanksgiving.

If read accurately, this verse actually states that the animals that should 'not be refused' are 'sanctified by the word of YHWH', the only animals that have been sanctified within the Scriptures are clean.

Where in the word has YHWH ever sanctified swine or shellfish or insects or any unclean animal? Nowhere! YHWH actually states that these animals are an abomination, he most certainly does not, anywhere in Scripture, sanctify these animals. Therefore, this verse could not possibly be pointing to the cleansing of unclean animals through prayer.


### ABOMINABLE TABLE



- Being clean and being holy are intricately linked all throughout the scriptures. Consider these scriptures:
- Leviticus 10:9-11 Do not drink wine or intoxicating drink, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of meeting, lest you die. It shall be a statute forever throughout your generations, 10 "that you may distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean, 11 "and that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which YHWH has spoken to them by the hand of Moses."



Ezekiel 22:26 "Her priests have violated My law and profaned My holy things; they have not distinguished between the holy and unholy, nor have they made known the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they have hidden their eyes from My Sabbaths, so that I am profaned among them.



1 Corinthians 7:14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy.

Leviticus 11:44 'For I am Yahweh your Elohim. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.

Through these scriptures we see that holiness and sanctification are intricately linked with cleanness and becoming unholy is directly associated with being defiled or unclean. Unclean and sanctified are biblical antonyms - an animal cannot be both biblically unclean and biblically sanctified.

Leviticus 15:46 'This is the law of the animals and the birds and every living creature that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth, 47 to distinguish between the unclean and the clean, and between the animal that may be eaten and the animal that may not be eaten."

YHWH makes a clear distinction between clean and unclean in scripture.



<sup>\*</sup> In the King James Version, Leviticus 11:18 and Deuteronomy 14:16 list "swan" among unclean birds. However, this seems to be a mistranslation. The original word apparently refers to a kind of owl and is so translated in most modern Bible versions.

## EATING HALAL

# Face it Sam is evil

### Dear Islam,

There is no God called Allah.

Your fascist ideology is not the

'Religion of Peace'.

Muhammad was a warlord, cult leader and false Prophet.

Muhammad awarded himself special 'privileges 'of the flesh...then he married a child. But one day, not too dissimilar to the others before it, I took particular notice of the Halal sign displayed at the shop front. A sign and term I was familiar with and had seen many times and had never really paid much attention to, now jumped out at me like a big sign.





I began to think about what halal food was and what made halal food.. well.. halal? Upon some light research I found that halal food was food that was not only in accordance with Muslim dietary law, but food that was literally consecrated and dedicated to Allah; a false god, a god that is not mine, an idol.



### WHAT IS HALAL MEAT?

Muslims can only eat meat that has been slaughtered according to a procedure called "dhabiha." This means that the living, breathing animal (a cow, for instance) is hung upside down and its throat is slit with a sharp knife. The animal then hangs there until it bleeds to death.

This procedure is controversial in part because generally the cow is not stunned or numbed before the cut. Since cows, like humans, are sentient creatures, this means that they feel a significant amount of pain before they die.



You won't notice the difference



But the poor animal sure did!



Muslims are not allowed to consume blood, so this is why the cow must be thoroughly drained before being butchered.

The other significant non-negotiable requirement for meat to be labeled halal is that an Islamist prayer must be recited as the animal is dying.

This prayer, the "shahada" or Muslim statement of faith, is very specific: "There is no god but Allah and Muhammed is his messenger."

When a Muslim says that "there is no god but Allah" he or she really means, "there is no god but Allah."

Thus, the method of slaughter and the accompanying prayer that make the meat halal are in compliance with Islamic Sharia Law.

## WHAT IS HALAL MEAT?

- \*Meat slaughtered according to Islamic Law
  --- Muslims cannot eat other meat
- \*Animal's throat cut while it is still conscious and blood drained from it's veins
- \*Animals are not always stunned during the process, meaning they endure significant pain
- \*The RSPCA says''slaughter without pre-stunning is unacceptable"

### HOW EATING HALAL MADE ME FEEL

At first, I felt quite confronted by the realisation that for the most part of my life, through sheer ignorance, I had been consuming meat dedicated to a god other than mine. Though this initial feeling of shame and confrontation faded as remembered the loving, understanding and compassionate nature of YHWH. Through His grace and His son Yahshua's sacrifice we and are able to turn from our sins towards spiritual growth! I now go online to check what foods are Halal and make a conscious choice not to eat them.

The prayer made over Halal food not only consecrates the animal to Allah, but actually denies the supremacy of any other god above Allah, such as the true G-d, YHWH. consuming Halal foods, I believe we absorb these blasphemous words into our bodies, and defile a place which is to be as a residence for the Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit): 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 'Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from YHWH? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honour YHWH with your bodies.'

Yahuwah also addresses the consumption of foods sacrificed to false gods and idols within the scriptures:

- 1 Corinthians 10:20-21 The things which the Gentiles sacrifice they sacrifice to demons and not to Yahuwah, and I do not want you to have fellowship with demons. 21 You cannot drink the cup of Yahuwah and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of Yahuwah's table and of the table of demons.
- 1 Corinthians teaches us that animals sacrificed to other gods are sacrificed to demons, because false gods are demons and sent by Satan to lead people astray.
- 1 Corinthians 10:28 But if anyone says to you, "This was offered to idols," do not eat it for the sake of the one who told you, and for conscience' sake.
- 1 Corinthians tells us not to eat food sacrificed to idols for our conscience' sake, as eating food sacrificed to idols is a sin.

Acts 15:29 You must abstain from eating food offered to idols, from consuming blood or the meat of strangled animals, and from sexual immorality.

Acts 15 blatantly tells us to abstain from foods offered to idols and false gods, such as Allah.

We can see that throughout scripture, Yahuwah commands us not to eat food sacrificed or offered to idols/other gods. Eating halal food, is eating food which has been sacrificed in the name of another god and consecrated to another god. Regardless of whether the animal is clean according to the Torah, if it has been consecrated or offered to a false god, it becomes defiled and therefore unclean for us to consume.

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
