YAH MADE A COVENANT WITH THE HEBREWS

- Yehovah made a covenant with Avraham saying: <u>'To your descendants I have given this land..." (Genesis 15:18).</u>
- It is interesting to note that the Hebrew verb used in the Scriptures is *natati*, meaning "I have given" (past tense). This passage implies that YHWH had already given the land to the Jews at some earlier time, though this is the first record of such a promise. Rabbinic commentators suggest, however, that Yah had set aside the land of Israel for His people already at the time of Creation.

ISRAEL WAS THE FABRIC OF CREATION

- In other words, the Jewish rights to the land were always part of the very fabric of Creation. They are eternal and unconditional. YHWH promised Avraham, "I will give to you, and to your descendants after you, the land of your sojourning, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession."
- YHWH also covenanted with Ishmael, regarded as the father of the Arab people. However, that promise was for nationhood, not land. But the land of Israel was not just a Divine promise. It was also the home of our forefathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and their wives, Sarah, Rebekah, Rachel and Leah.

"The eyes of the Lord... are always upon it, from the beginning of the year to the end of the year" (Deuteronomy 11:12).



It is a "Very, very good land" (Nu. 14:7); "a blessed land" (Deut. 33:13); "the beauty of all lands" (Ezek 20:6).

Isaiah 62 - A Glorious Future for Zion

- For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns. The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory. You shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD will name. You shall also be a crown of glory in the hand of YHWH, and a royal diadem In the hand of your Yah.
- I will not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness: Isaiah prophesied in a time when Jerusalem was still a functioning city, but was spiritually corrupt. Here, he looks forward to the time when Jerusalem is desolate because she has been conquered by the Babylonians, and prophetically speaks comfort and assurance to her discouraged and downcast citizens. YHWH assures them that He will not rest until Jerusalem is restored in a shining righteousness.



HOW THE NAME OF ISRAEL WAS CHANGED TO PALESTINE

 The name, Palestine, was a regional name that was imposed on the area by the Roman Emperor, Hadrian, who suppressed the Second Jewish Revolt in AD 135. He was so angry with the Jews that he wanted to humiliate them and emphasize that the Jewish nation had lost its right to a homeland under Roman rule. The name Palaestina was originally an adjective derived from Philistia, the arch-enemies of the Israelites 1000 years earlier. Hadrian also changed the name of Jerusalem to Aelia Capitolina after his own family name, Aelia. He also forbade Jews from entering the city, except on the 9th of the Hebrew month Av, to mourn its destruction.

Emperor Hadrian's name has lived on through the ages thanks to his colourful legends, but few know that he was responsible for the slaughter of 600,000 Jews. Yet when he had ascended the imperial throne 18 years before, Hadrian was hailed as one of the most enlightened and peaceloving of all emperors.





HADRIAN: Emperor of the 'First Holocaust'

 Since he was considered a god in the Roman Empire, this was his attempt to break YHWH's covenant between the Jewish people and their land. This effectively declared his pagan authority over Jerusalem, which had been the place of the presence of the Yahweh of Israel. To this day, the name Palestine flies in the face of Israel and the entire issue can be boiled down to a religious (spiritual) battle over a land whose fate will be decided by the G-d of the Bible; since it is His land (Leviticus 25:23).

HISTORY OF THE OTTOMANS IN THE HOLY LAND

- The rule of the Ottoman Empire in the Holy Land, which began in the early 16th century following their defeat of the Mamluks, lasted until 1922 (the end of World World I) after which Great Britain gained control of Israel.
- The Ottoman Empire faced internal problems, since their reign lacked organization and there were frequent disputes regarding succession. However, they were able to amass great wealth by controlling the main trade routes and charging for access. They were overall a tolerant people, allowing religious groups to keep their laws and traditions without interfering.



THE HOLY LAND UNDER OTTOMAN RULE

- During Ottoman rule, the religious minorities in Israel—Jews and Christians—lived through both periods of prosperity and of persecution.
- The Jewish population thrived during the first part of Ottoman rule. Jews were allowed to practice their religion, and the city of Safed (Tsfat), in the Galilee, saw a rebirth of Jewish life. The Holy Land became a refuge for Jews fleeing persecution in Crusader Europe, and for the most part the sultans tolerated, often openly embracing, the Jews.



THE KORAN GLORIFIES KILLING JEWS AS THE HIGHEST HONOR

 The conflict in the Middle East between Islam and the Jewish people began in the seventh century with Mohamed whose koran incites his followers to kill Jews in the name of Allah. It is a fallacy that this conflict goes back thousands of years. This site is dedicated to exploring the facts and myth regarding the nation state of Israel. As long as the koran exists, as long as the hundreds of passages that glorify killing Jews as the greatest honor a Muslim can achieve, the conflict will continue. "Occupation" is an excuse Muslims use to viewed as victims. This conflict has nothing to do with "occupation", it has nothing to do with US policy in the Middle East. as it is a continuation of every war the Arab World has waged since the time of Mohamed.

1918 HERALDED A MASSIVE ALIYAH OF JEWS RETURNING HOME

- Following the British conquest of the land, Arabs from neighbouring countries started a massive 30-year invasion of the Land of Israel, to look for jobs and to fulfil their religious obligation to capture as much foreign land as possible. These Arabs came from other countries, none of them had any historical connection to the Land of Israel.
- In 1918 Great Britain conquered the Land of Israel. This was the end of the Ottoman Empire and saw the true beginning of *Aliyah*—Jews returning home to settle their land, the land of Israel.





Jeremiah 31:35-36 declares: "This is what the Lord says, 'He who appoints the sun to shine by day, Who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night, Who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar -- the Lord Almighty is His Name; Only if these ordinances vanish from My sight,' declares the Lord, 'will the descendants of Israel ever cease to be a nation before Me.'





THE GREAT SOUTHLAND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

 I sometimes am amazed at Christians in Australia. Many ask, what is the future for this country? What plan does YHWH have for this sunburnt land? If one believes that Smith Wigglesworth was a true prophet of the Lord (and I do), he prophesied that these "ANZAC" islands of the South Pacific, (Australia and New Zealand) would herald in the last great move of the Holy Spirit. But do we have anything else to go on? Personally I believe we do. I believe that YHWH is no man's debtor. IT WAS AUSSIE'S WHO FREED JERUSALEM

- Jerusalem was to remain firmly in the hands of the Turks right up until the 19th century when 800 Aussie Light Horsemen rode into history and opened the gateway to Jerusalem.
- However history has not been kind to these magnificent mounted Aussies. Not only is this magnificent and historical feat not known by the world but even most Australians are unfamiliar with what their forefathers achieved. Even the capture of Damascus was accredited to Lawrence of Arabia and his Arab army, but the truth is the Aussie Light Horsemen had taken the city one week earlier but had to hide out of sight while Lawrence's ego was appeased, allowing him to parade into the city!



AUSTRALIAN SOLDIERS IN WW1

- World War I took a large toll on a young Australian nation, federated only 13 years before in 1901. From a population of fewer than five million, 416,809 Australian men enlisted, including 2,304 Jewish Australians – 10 percent of the total Jewish population at that time. Over 156,000 Australians were wounded or taken prisoner. Over 60,000 Australians were killed.
- Their names are written on memorials in the public squares of Australian towns and cities. Their graves lie scattered across far-flung fields of Europe and the Middle East.

ALMOST A century on, the sacrifice of these young Australians says something about Australia's values and its vision of its place in the world. During World War I and other major conflicts of the twentieth century, young Australian men and women answered the call of duty in faraway places.



The Israel-Anzac Connection 90 Years On

- Every year more and more Australians and New Zealanders travel to Turkey and Europe to pay homage to the Anzacs which formed such an important part of the common heritage of our two countries. With the 90th Anniversary of ANZAC, the level of awareness of the ANZAC tradition will reach its zenith.
- The Beersheba charge enabled ANZAC forces to spearhead the entry of the British army into Jerusalem in 1917. Australian and New Zealand forces fought battles all over the land which is now Israel. These ANZAC military deeds were an integral link in the chain of historical events which finally led to the establishment of the state of Israel in 1948. Sadly, many ANZAC soldiers died in these victorious campaigns, many of them are buried in Commonwealth cemeteries in Israel. ANZAC forces, in conjunction with Palestinian Jewish volunteers in the British army also played an important role in the allied war effort in World War II and many were stationed in Israel to eventually fight in campaigns in Syria and Egypt.

FACTS ABOUT THE AUSSIE/JEWISH CONNECTION

The history of the Jews in Australia dates back to 1788, when a number of Jews were among the convicts brought to the country aboard the First Fleet to establish the first European settlement on the continent, on the site of present-day Sydney. Today, an estimated 120,000 Jews live in Australia. The majority are Ashkenazi Jews, many of them refugees and Holocaust survivors who arrived during and after World War II. There is also a significant Sephardic Jewish population.

- The Australian-Jewish general John Monash was a leader of the Australian Zionist movement. Australians soldiers fought in the Middle East in World War II.
- The Australian foreign minister H.V. Evatt served as Chairman of the UN General Assembly's Ad Hoc Committee on Palestine and helped to push through the UN Partition Plan on November 29, 1947.

- Australia was the first country to vote in favour of the plan despite heavy pressure from the United Kingdom on its fellow Commonwealth nations to abstain on the resolution.
- Full diplomatic relations were established on 29 January 1949.
- A little known fact is that Israel's legendary former Defence Minister. Moshe Dayan lost his eye which obliged him to wear his famous eye patch whilst serving with Australian troops in the campaign against Vichy French forces in Syria during WWII.
- In more recent years Australian forces in particular, have served in both United Nations and multinational peacekeeping and border monitoring assignments on Israel's borders with Syria and Egypt. Australian SAS troops in the recent Iraq conflict have been widely credited with neutralising the threat to Israel of Iraqi scud missiles.



800 AUSTRALIAN LIGHTHORSEMEN LIBERATE JERUSALEM

- The following prophecy was given regarding Jerusalem in the book of Isaiah: "As birds flying, so will the LORD of hosts DEFEND JERUSALEM; defending also HE WILL deliver it; and passing over HE WILL preserve it" (ISAIAH 31:5).
- Many recognize that the deliverance of Jerusalem in 1917 was miraculous. The city was taken WITHOUT A SINGLE SHOT BEING FIRED, or without a building being damaged. This was without precedent in World War 1!
- It was one of the FIRST TIMES THAT AEROPLANES HAD BEEN USED in warfare and the way the city was delivered WAS BY THE PLANES flying over and dropping messages promising peace to the people. The Turks fled in panic!

FULFILLMENT OF YHWH'S PROMISE

- It was not actually the INVADING BRITISH, BUT the AUSTRALIAN LIGHT HORSE who paved the way to victory by taking Beersheba!
- Winston Churchill wrote: "From the uttermost ends of the earth, ships and soldiers are approaching or gathering in the eastern Mediterranean in FULFILMENT OF A DESTINY AS YET NOT UNDERSTOOD BY MORTAL MAN.
- The arrival of the ANZACS in Egypt created the NUCLEUS OF THE ARMY NEEDED TO ATTACK THE HEART OF THE TURKISH EMPIRE."

THE 4TH REGIMENT OF AUSTRALIAN LIGHTHORSE




Israel could only be freed from 400 years of Ottoman Turk rule by the liberation of Jerusalem. With the introduction of the British General, Sir George Allenby, and his confidence in his Australian Officer in Charge, Lt.-General Harry Chauvel, a change in history was to occur.



Beersheba - Well Of The Oath

- The key to the battle were the Gaza-Beersheba fortifications. Beersheba, meaning "well of the oath", so named by Avraham in the book of Genesis. The well had provided water not only to Avraham, but to Moshe and David.
- Any army approaching its life-giving wells has to march for days through the waterless Sinai desert. All the Turks had to do was hold off an attack for one day and the merciless desert sun would do the rest. Despite constant assaults by the combined forces of the British and Australian armies, the place could not be taken.

Beersheba and its Connections

The Fateful day of October 31, 1917

"The generals were desperate! 50,000 British infantry with tank support had been driven back into the desert. With the sun about to set and with no water for many miles - disaster stared them squarely in the face. The Australian Light Horse Commander Chauvel's orders were to storm Beersheba; it had to be won before nightfall at all costs. The situation was becoming grave as they were in **urgent need of 400,000 gallons of water** for men and horses."

"Chauvel concocted a crazy plan. Why not let his 800 horsemen charge the Turkish artillery? A cavalry charge across 6000 yards of open terrain straight into the face of the amassed Turkish guns. It sounded like a recipe for disaster. No wonder the German Officer commanding the Turkish defences described the Aussie Light Horsemen as "madmen!"



 "For a start the Light Horse were not cavalry, they were mounted infantry. They had no swords or lancers but were equipped with rifles and bayonets designed for infantry warfare. But left with virtually no alternative the desperate General gave the order for the last great cavalry charge in history!"

• "The 800 young men mounted their magnificent Walers (horses) and lined up to face the Turkish guns. Their young faces bronzed and tanned from the desert sun, their emu plumes swaying in the breeze from their famous slouch hats, rifles swung across their backs and bayonets in hand. History was about to be written. These 800 young men were about to open the doorway to the liberation of Jerusalem!"




Unknown to the Light Horsemen, through their efforts Yehovah was to use them as a major part of His promise - the return of the Land of Israel to His people. After many hard fought battles, it was realised that the Turkish line at Beersheba was the gateway to Jerusalem.

"The Light Horsemen charged magnificently across the dusty plains, so fast that the Turkish artillery could not keep pace with them and the "mad" horsemen were able to slip under their guns. As they leapt the trenches laced with machine gun bullets, a magnificent cheer went up from the British ranks, even some of the Turks stood and applauded, such was the magnificence of the feat."



 "For the first time in 400 years, the road to Jerusalem was open, the Muslim stranglehold on the Holy Land was at last broken."

 Although hopelessly outnumbered and outgunned they charged on. Beersheba the gateway to Jerusalem, fell that day, not to the Crusaders, not to the British, German or US Armies - but to the Australian Light Horsemen!



TAKING BACK THE HOLY LAND

- "Numbers of nations claim to have made the greatest cavalry charge in history, but what eleven Crusades had been UNABLE TO ACHIEVE, had been achieved by 800 young fresh-faced AUSTRALIAN Light Horsemen.
- YAHWEH HAD USED ONE OF THE SMALLEST and YOUNGEST nations in the world as His spearhead to OPEN THE GATEWAY to His chosen city - Jerusalem. They had achieved the impossible!"

HEROIC AUSTRALIAN'S FREE JERUSALEM

- The next day the British Commanding General remarked as he walked over the ground where the charge had taken place, "Words fail me, I cannot see how these horsemen were able to achieve what they did. Every rule of war says they should have been annihilated!"
- Australia, the youngest nation in the world, was a vital key in opening the gateway to the ancient city of Jerusalem. On the same day as the Beersheba charge, the British Government drafted the Balfour Declaration, which was the foundation for the recognition of the State of Israel.

The Australian Light Horse were the first to ride into Jerusalem, being the honour guard to the British General Allenby at the Tower of David.




THE ANZAC'S FREE THE ISRAEL

- This was the first foreign army in the history of Israel to take Jerusalem, only to give it back, giving freedom to the Jewish people, and not taking it for themselves. Many of the Light Horsemen were visibly moved when they realised they had opened the gateway to the Holy Land, a doorway which had been firmly shut for centuries.
- One writer put it this way "Without the ANZAC involvement the modern state of Israel would not have come into existence!"
- On December 11th, 1917 the Australian Light Horsemen rode triumphantly into Jerusalem, so far from their homes, their emu feathers proudly fluttering in the breeze, to be greeted with a hysterical welcome by Jews and Christians.

THE BALFOUR DECLARATION

- November 2, 1917
- The British government publishes the Balfour Declaration, signed by its foreign secretary, Lord James Arthur Balfour. The Declaration addressed to Lord Lionel Rothschild who is asked to bring it to the attention of the "Zionist Federation" - includes an expression of support for the founding of a "national home" for the Jews in Palestine. There is great joy throughout the Jewish world, on both fronts.

November 2nd, 1917.

Dear Lord Rothschild.

I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on behalf of His Majesty's Government, the following declaration of sympathy with Jewish Zionist aspirations which has been submitted to, and approved by, the Cabinet

"His Majesty's Government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavours to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country"

I should be grateful if you would bring this declaration to the knowledge of the Zionist Pederation.

A NATIONAL HOMELAND FOR THE JEWS.

- In 1917, the Balfour Declaration was secured from Great Britain and endorsed by the League of Nations through the British mandate for Palestine.
- The mandate explicitly provided for Jewish national rights while safeguarding the civil and personal rights of non-Jews in Mandatory Palestine.
- In fact, the mandate was given to Britain for the specific purpose of facilitating Jewish immigration, settlement, and the establishment of a "national home for the Jewish people".

BRITISH ARMY AND ZION MULE CORPS CONQUEORS GAZA

November 1917 Throughout the first half of the month, the British army advances rapidly northwards, conquering Gaza in southern Palestine, Jaffa and Tel Aviv, Lod, Ramle and the surrounding area. The next step is to take possession of Jerusalem.



DAVID BEN-GURION

An additional Jewish regiment, the 39th Battalion of Royal Fusiliers, established in the United States, participates in the battles for Palestine with the British army. Among its organizers and first recruits are **David Ben-Gurion** (who later becomes Israel's first Prime Minister.



December 9, 1917

On the eve of Chanukah, the British army enters Jerusalem. It meets no resistance as the Turks have secretly left the city.





December 11, 1917 - The formal date of the conquest of Jerusalem. General Allenby enters the city victoriously. Upon reaching Jaffa Gate, he dismounts from his horse and enters the Holy City on foot. Four hundred years of Turkish rule have come to an end.



1917 WAS YAH'S APPOINTED TIME FOR ISRAEL TO BE REBORN

 The year of 1917 brought jubilation to Jewry around the world. Announced in London by Lord Balfour, was a declaration and a promise - the establishment in the land of Palestine as a homeland for the Jewish people. The hope of our people was rekindled.... the long awaited promise that Yahweh had given Avraham; that His ancient people would one day return from their exile, being re-gathered from the four corners of the earth. What was once a time worn faded dream, corroded in the hearts of our homeless people, had been announced as concrete reality.



LORD BALFOUR AND GENERAL ALLENBY




Jeremiah 16:14-17


Extracts from Col Stringer's book "800 Light Horsemen"

AUSTRALIA AND ISRAEL RELATIONSHIP SINCE 1917

- Australia and Israel enjoy a warm and cooperative relationship. In the 1950s and 1960s, many Australians volunteered on kibbutzim in Israel. The Liberal-Country Party Coalition supported Israel during and after the 1967 Six-Day War. In the 1980s, Bob Hawke opposed the UN resolution equating Zionism with racism. Ties with Israel were strengthened under Prime Minister John Howard and Foreign Minister Alexander Downer, who supported Israel in the 2006 Lebanon War.
- Australia has an embassy in Tel Aviv and Israel likewise in Canberra. In Israel, Anzac Day is commemorated at the Commonwealth War cemetery on Mount Scopus in Jerusalem. The Australian Soldier Park in Beersheba is dedicated to the memory of the Australian Light Horse regiment that charged at Beersheba and defeated the Turks in World War I.

AUSTRALIA REMAINS AN ALLY TO ISRAEL

 Today, as in 1917, Australia is a country of strong, democratic values. It believes in good international citizenship. This means doing our part, as a middle power with the world's thirteenth largest economy, fourteenth largest defence budget, and a tradition of innovative diplomacy, to build a more peaceful, stable and prosperous global order. Australia is geographically distant from the Middle East, but we believe, as we did in 1917, that our interests are directly engaged here. We continue to work for a peaceful and secure Middle East, and Australia remains unshakably committed to Israel's security, as it faces its many challenges. By ANDREA **FAULKNER**

- "But Yah has chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and Yah has chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things that are mighty; and base things of the world, and things which are despised, has Yah chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are" Cor. I 27, 28).
- In the Old Testament, Yah seldom used those who appeared to be the "most likely to succeed." He used Moses, who was an escaped fugitive and who made all kinds of excuses as to why he was not the one Yah needed to deliver the nation Israel from its Egyptian bondage. He used David to kill Goliath, in spite of his youth and the disparaging comments of his brothers. He used Samson and Balaam, and even Balaam's donkey.

- The New Testament is no different. He used "foot in mouth" Peter to play a major role in the proclamation of the gospel, and yet Peter was a man who denied Yahshua publicly. The Apostle Paul summed up Yah's amazing way of using the most unlikely people when he wrote: "Think about the circumstances of your call, brothers and sisters. Not many were wise by human standards, not many were powerful, not many were born to a privileged position. But Yah chose what the world thinks foolish to shame the wise, and Yah chose what the world thinks weak to shame the strong. Yah chose what is low and despised in the world, what is regarded as nothing, to set aside what is regarded as something, so that no one can boast in his presence."
- He is the reason you have a relationship with Yahshua HaMaschiach, who for us wisdom from Yah, and righteousness and sanctification and redemption, 31 so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord" (1 Corinthians 1:26-31).
